Denene Eagleton, owner of Norman General Store Quilt shop will donate a quilt made from her fabric, by Joan Behnke, and quilted by Anne Sinkula for their fundraiser activity this fall.

“Women’s Day” at the Manitowoc County Fair was brought up by President Lindy, as a way to promote our guild and attract new members. Joan Behnke has agreed to organize a committee to pursue this.

The day would be held before the fair, with a quilt square contest. This year theme would be Stars and Stripes. Quilt would be judged by popular vote of the attendees. The winners of the quilt square contest and depending on number of squares entered could be made into a quilt by our guild members, and then raffled off at the next years Womens Day event. **Where:** Cabin #1 at Lincoln Park in Manitowoc

**How does it work?**

**For the swap:** Bring any fabric, notions, patterns, quilt-related items or household decor you think someone else might want and you'd like to declutter. You spread all your stuff out on a table, then go "shopping" at other tables. When we are finished, any of your stuff that's left is your responsibility to pack up and take home. The price for everything is free.

**For the dinner:** The committee is providing a broasted chicken picnic and bottled water. If you want a different beverage you'll need to BYOB.

What else do I need to bring? Besides your swap items, please bring a large bag to carry the treasures you find, a folding table if you have one, a fat quarter (or more) of red, white or blue fabric (optional). This will be put in bundles to later make patriotic quilts to donate. Don't forget your name tag!

If you are not meeting for breakfast, camp will open at approx. 9:20 am.
