
Wool Workshop

The Wool Workshop will be presented by Tammy VanderBloomen on Saturday, September 16th, from 9am to 3pm at Ascend Services. Cost of the workshop is \$35 plus the kit cost. Please include the registration fee of \$35 with your completed registration form. (page 6)

The kits will be paid for on the day of the workshop. Cost of the Ring of Hearts kit is \$26.50. Cost of the Americana Mat is \$32.00.



The cost for each includes the backing and tax. A list of supplies will be sent at a later date. Lunch is on your own.







Why does it cost so much to get the newsletter mailed to me?

The ink and stamps are what make the newsletter cost so much to mail.

The table below shows costs for a newsletter with 3 sheets of paper, though newsletters can also be 4 sheets. Also, the ink price is based on a best case scenario and would likely cost more per side.
