Why does it cost so much to get the newsletter mailed to me?

The ink and stamps are what make the newsletter cost so much to mail.

The table below shows costs for a newsletter with 3 sheets of paper, though newsletters can also be 4 sheets. Also, the ink price is based on a best case scenario and would likely cost more per side.

Ink (0.21 per side)	0.21 x 6 sides = 1.26	13.86

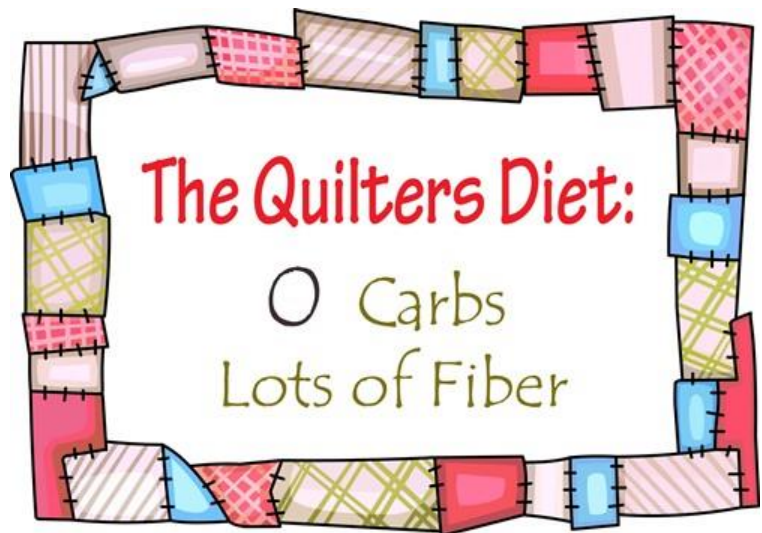

Clue 5

Sew your rows together.
The Jelly Roll blocks are **horizontal** and the Background blocks are **vertical**.
Press to the Jelly Roll Blocks.

Large Quilt:

7 Blocks per row.
7 Rows.

Medium Quilt:

5 Blocks per row.
7 Rows.

Small Quilt:

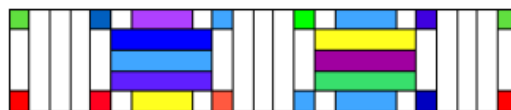
5 Blocks per row.
5 Rows.

Large Quilt: Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7

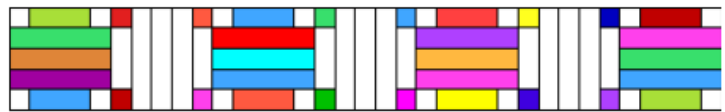


Medium Quilt: Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7

Final Assembly:

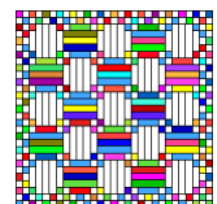
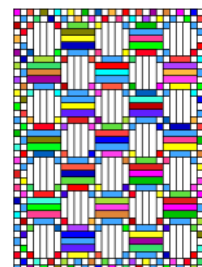
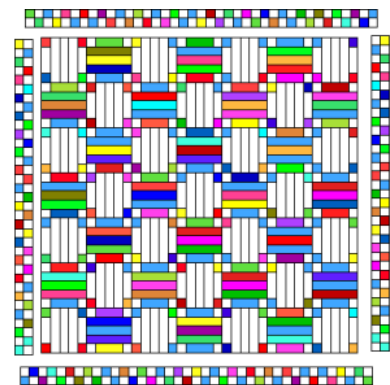
Sew the rows of blocks together, nesting seams.

(The Jelly Roll squares in the outside corners.)

Press to the border.

Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt.
(The Jelly Roll squares in the outside corners.)

Press to the border.
