# **It's Mystery Time Again!**

#### Clue # 1 Cutting

Grab your stash bins and dig out a wide variety of scraps.



Cut the following squares and rectangles for your chosen size.

Fabric / Size	Table Topper	Lap Quilt	Twin	Full	Queen	King
Scrappy 4 inch squares	44	100	120	150	210	280
Background 4 inch squares	44	100	120	150	210	280
Background 3 ½ inch squares	16	40	48	60	84	112
Background 3 ½ x 6 ½ inch rectangles	20	40	48	60	84	112

The wider variety of scrappy prints, the better it will look. I recommend at least a dozen different prints, and the more the better. This is not a busy design, and would be great in two colors like blue and white, or red and cream. There is a great deal of background, and the design did best with white or cream.
